DIRECTIONS TO OAKLAND UNIVERSITY – OAKLAND CENTER

Take I-75 north from the metro Detroit area or south from the Saginaw area to Exit 79, University Drive. Go east about 1 mile on University Drive. University Drive ends at a traffic circle as you enter campus. Follow the traffic circle around until you come to Meadowbrook Drive (the second exit off the traffic circle). Turn right on Meadowbrook Drive and proceed to the middle section of Parking Lot 1 on your left. The Oakland Center is directly across the street.
